### Educational Column:

**Question No. 1:** In basketball, what is the minimum number of contests required to meet sports sponsorship in Bylaw 20.10.3.5 (minimum contests and participants requirements for sports sponsorship)?

**Answer:** The minimum number of contests in basketball an institution must complete to meet the sports-sponsorship requirement is 22.

**Question No. 2:** If Proposal No. 2010-8 is adopted, will there be modifications made to the championships selection criteria for basketball?

**Answer:** No. The Championships Committee decided at this time to make no changes to the current minimum number of contests for selection criteria purposes. The committee agreed to review this subject as the Life in the Balance initiative is a multiyear initiative, and future changes may be necessary.
