ILC determined that any necessary pre-enrollment information not provided to all prospective students regarding orientation, academics, workout and conditioning activities may be provided to a prospective student-athlete after the prospective student-athlete's paid acceptance of the institution's written offer of admission and/or financial aid. Permissible workout and conditioning information to be provided to the prospective student-athlete may include an individual-workout program.
