VI. Legislation update- Sue Ramsey and Shannon Reynolds

- Beth and Shannon were in attendance at the NCAA National Convention where their focus was on Division III male practice players
- The following legislation was discussed on call:
  - #4 (2-5) ADOPTED- Eliminate texting prior to NLI
    - Effective August 1, 2008
  - #15 (2-10) DEFEATED- Medical exams and updates one year prior
  - #5 (2-12) ADOPTED- Male Practice Players certification
    - Effective August 1, 2008
  - #7 (2-15) ADOPTED- Increase core course requirements from 14 to 16
    - Effective August 1, 2013
  - #18 (2-16) ADOPTED- Athletic activities outside of playing season prohibited one week prior to exams
    - Effective August 1, 2008
  - #8 (2-17) ADOPTED- More than one group for skill instruction
    - Effective August 1, 2008
  - #19 (2-18) DEFEATED First on court practice 7pm on the Friday nearest October 15
  - #20 DEFEATED-First contest second Friday of November
