To establish an exception for telephone communication with a prospective student-athlete (or the prospective student-athlete's relatives, legal guardians or coach) during the July evaluation periods and during the time periods in which the prospect is participating in nonscholastic events, provided the prospective student-athlete has graduated from high school and has signed a National Letter of Intent (NLI) with the institution or for those institutions not using the NLI in women's basketball or for those prospective student-athletes who are not eligible to sign the NLI, the institution's written offer of admission and/or financial aid.
