

A Highlight of the Division I Summer Access/Recruiting Calendar Survey Results

As a response to the Women’s Basketball Issues Committee (WBIC) work on summer school and access, the WBCA sent out a survey on September 4, 2008, to all the Division I Head Coach and Associate Head Coach members. The survey was designed to gather feedback from the DI coaches on what their thoughts, feelings, and opinion are for summer school and summer access. The survey was sent to 371 Head and Associate Head Coaches. We received a 70% response back. 88 institutions did not respond to the survey. The following is a highlight of some of the results from the survey:
